(3) Embraces God's Purposes for His Life (Isaiah 53:10-12)

¹⁰ But the LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief; If (when) He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see His offspring, He will prolong His days, and the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand. ¹¹ As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see it and be satisfied; by His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, as He will bear their iniquities. ¹² Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great (many), and He will divide the booty with the strong; because He poured out Himself to death, and was numbered with the transgressors; Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, and interceded for the transgressors. (Is 53:10-12 NASB)

"As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see it and be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, as He will bear their iniquities" (Isaiah 53:11).

- "Result of the anguish"

3. Blessings from His Death (53:12)

"Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors" (53:12 ESV).

- "divide him a portion with the many"
- "shall divide the spoil with the strong"



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Translation Confusion (Is 53:12)

“Therefore, I will allot Him a portion **with the great**, and He will divide the booty with the strong; Because He poured out Himself to death, and was numbered with the transgressors; Yet He Himself bore the sin **of many**, and interceded for the transgressors” (53:12 NASB).

“Therefore I will divide him a portion **with the many**, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin **of many**, and makes intercession for the transgressors.” (53:12 ESV).

- 4 Reasons
 - ➡ “Poured out his soul to death”
 - ➡ “Was numbered with the transgressors”
 - ➡ “He bore the sin of many”
 - ➡ “Makes intercession for the transgressors”

“The Spirit Himself intercedes for us” (Romans 8:26). “Christ Jesus ... who also intercedes for us” (Romans 8:34). “Hence, also, He is able to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them” (Hebrews 7:25).
