3) Leadership Is Characterized By Service

4) Faithful Service Brings Great Rewards

"Well done, good and faithful slave; you were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master" (Matthew 25:22-23).

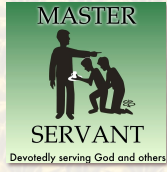
